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CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

What happened to the Y2K scare? Was it cyber fear; or was it an oversight at the beginning of the computer age and was something that could have been catastrophic when the clock struck midnight? The lesson about this phenomenon is not to understand the problem itself, but to learn from the methods used to solve it with thorough and exhausting preparation and modification of thousands of lines of code, the testing, and finally the validation of the results, to eliminate any significant consequence.

These are the same methods that CLRC uses in the day-to-day activities in the registry process. Since 1905, the CLRC has had nine different General Managers and sixty-eight different Chairmen of the Board. Through 95 years, and all these different people, the consistent objective of CLRC has been to provide to all the Member Associations, a cost effective, accurate and detailed registry and database recovery service that could be called upon at anytime to reliably support the information on the animal's certificate.

Consistent with this legacy, CLRC is well into the next generation computer system that will, with no sacrifice of integrity of data, enhance the ease-of-use, and speed of input and recovery of data. Fundamentally important is the fact that the ninety-five years of history of "doing it right" will be the basis on which all of tomorrow's transactions shall be carried out. Speed and accessibility are of value only if the information on the certificates is accurate and verifiable.

As we move forward in technology, the experience of the staff and management at CLRC; the 95 years of history; and the foresight of the Member Associations, will ensure that each and every individual of all of the Member Breed Association is provided with the quality of service they have come to expect.

Thank you, all the CLRC staff, and management, the members of the Board of Directors, and all the Member Associations for the effort and the results achieved in Year 2000.

CLRC eagerly anticipates continuing to be a key part of the Agriculture Industry in Canada, and the World.

RAPPORT DU PRÉSIDENT

Qu'est-ce qui c'est passé avec la grosse peur de l'an 2000? GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT

The year 2000 at CLRC can be summarized as one in which the statistics do not tell the whole story. During the year 89357 registrations and 27921 transfers were processed on behalf of approximately 13,000 members of the member breed associations. These numbers represent fairly significant decreases of 15% and 10% respectively from the numbers in 1999.

In spite of these numbers, however, it was a busy year of many positive accomplishments, as revealed by other numbers. The number of active member associations grew to 49 from 47, with membership applications being accepted from the Canadian Donkey and Mule Association and the Canadian Pinzgauer Association. The Canadian Shorthorn Association rescinded its intention to withdraw, although the Canadian Murray Grey Association did follow that path at the end of 2000. CLRC has also moved into providing services to breed associations based outside of Canada.

Although the number of units processed declined, there was a notable increase in revenue from other services provided by CLRC to member associations in the areas of special mailings to members, secretarial services, and special computer programming services. Also, the Canadian Swine Breeders Association signed a contract to sublet a portion of CLRC office space. The increases in activity in these areas reinforced the fact that CLRC is well positioned to provide services professionally and cost effectively.

A major step forward into the future taken during the year was the decision to replace the aging computer system that has served CLRC and its members so well since 1992. The new equipment arrived in stages in the latter part of the year, and the task of converting the database to the new platform commenced. This detailed work is nearing completion as this is written. The new equipment and state of the art operating system will greatly enhance CLRC's ability to increasingly perform its functions in an electronic setting.

As your General Manager, I very much appreciate your comments and feedback, and I have valued the opportunity to meet a significant number of people this past year at various meetings that I have attended. I also wish to thank the Chairman and Board of Directors, the staff of CLRC, and the members and staff of the member associations for their continued support and co-operation.

RAPPORT DU GÉRANT GÉNÉRAL

Sommairement, l'an 2000 à la SCEA était une année dans laquelle les statistiques ne disent pas l'histoire complète. Au cours de l'année, 89357 enregistrements et 27921 transferts de propriété ont été effectués aux noms d'environ 13000 membres de nos associations-membre. Ces nombres indiquent une diminution de 15% et de 10%, respectivement, versus les nombres en 1999.

En dépit de ces statistiques, c'était une année très occupée avec plusieurs accomplissements positifs, tel qu'indiqué par autres chiffres. Avec l'approbation de l'Association Canadienne des Ânes et Mules et la Société Canadienne Pinzgauer, nous avons maintenant 49 associations-membre. La Société Canadienne Shorthorn a annulé leur intention de quitter la SCEA mais l'Association Canadienne Murray Grey a quitté à la fin de 2000. La SCEA fournit aussi des services à plusieurs associations de race dont le siège social n'est pas au Canada.

Malgré que le nombre d'unités a baissé, il y avait une augmentation considérable dans les revenus générés par autres services fournis par la SCEA aux associations-membre – tel que des envoies postales spéciaux, des services de secrétaire et des services de programmation informatique. De plus, la Société Canadienne des Éleveurs de Porcs a signé un contrat pour sous-louer de l'espace de bureau dans le bureau de la SCEA.

L'augmentation des activités dans ces régions confirme le fait que la SCEA est bien placé pour fournir des services professionnels et économiques.

Une étape majeur au cours de la dernière année était la décision de remplacer le système informatique qui avait été acheté en 1992. Le nouvel équipement est arrivé en stages vers la fin de l'année et la conversion de la base de donnée progresse très bien. En rédigeant ce rapport, la conversion est presque complétée. Le nouvel équipement et la base de données super-moderne aideront à rehausser les capacités de la SCEA au niveau électronique.

Comme Gérant général, j'apprécie vos commentaires et je suis fier d'avoir rencontré plusieurs d'entre vous lors des assemblées auxquelles j'ai participé cette dernière année. Je désire aussi remercier le Président du Conseil d'administration, le personnel de la SCEA ainsi que les membres et le personnel des associations-membre pour leur appui et collaboration.

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

December 31, 2000

1. GENERAL

The Canadian Livestock Records Corporation [the "Corporation"] is a private non-profit organization that was established under Section 35 of the Animal Pedigree Act. The Corporation is the national pedigree service for purebred and non-purebred livestock in Canada. The Corporation is a non-profit organization as defined in Section 149(1)(l) of the Income Tax Act, and, as such, is exempt from income taxes.

2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial statements have been prepared by management in accordance with Canadian generally accepted accounting principles. Since precise determination of many assets and liabilities is dependent on future events, the preparation of periodic financial statements necessarily involves the use of estimates and approximations. These have been made using careful judgement. These financial statements present the assets and results of operations of the Corporation and have been prepared with reasonable limits of materiality and within the framework of the accounting policies summarized below. Because of the use of estimates, actual results may vary.

Fund accounting

The Corporation follows the deferral method of accounting for contributions. Restricted contributions related to the expenses of future periods are deferred and recognized as revenue in the period in which the related expenses are incurred.

Financial instruments

The carrying amount of the Corporation's current assets and liabilities, which consist of cash and short-term investments, accrued interest and other receivables, due from Breed Associations, accounts payable and accrued charges, accrued vacation pay, sick leave provision and due to Breed Associations, approximate their fair value given their short-term nature. As at December 31, 2000, the fair market value of the capital lease obligations approximated the carrying value of these obligations. Unless otherwise noted, it is managements' opinion that the Corporation is not exposed to significant interest, currency or credit risks arising from these financial instruments.

Capital assets and amortization

Capital assets are stated at cost and are amortized using the straight-line method over the following estimated useful lives:

Assets	Estimated useful life
Photocopier	5 years
Computer equipment	5 years
Computer software	5 years
Leasehold improvements	Life of the lease

Assets leased on terms that transfer substantially all the benefits and risk of ownership to the Corporation are accounted for as capital leases, as though the asset had been purchased and a liability incurred. Under this method of accounting for leases, the asset is amortized on a straight-line basis consistent with similar purchased assets and the interest on the obligation charged to income over the life of the lease.

Sick leave and severance pay

The Corporation has a sick leave policy which currently allows the payment of two days of accumulated sick leave per complete year of service to a maximum of 60 days. The payment is due to all terminated full-time employees employed for ten years or more as long as termination is not for cause. The current provision is intended to fully provide for this potential liability should all employees be eligible for the maximum pay-out.

Deferred revenue and reserve fund

Upon withdrawal, member associations are assessed a charge related to their share of committed future costs. This charge is deferred and then amortized to income as the costs are incurred.

The reserve fund represents an accumulation of operating surpluses and deficits over the life of the corporation. The purpose of the reserve fund is to assist in the funding of future capital outlays and to cover operating deficits. Upon withdrawal, member associations are entitled to their share of the reserve fund.

Pension plan

The Corporation provides pension benefits for its employees through a defined contribution pension plan. The Corporation's share of the annual contribution to the pension plan is charged to expense in the year in which the contribution is made. The amount of contributions included in the pension expense that relates to the pension plan is \$14,189 [1999 - \$14,803].

3. SHORT-TERM INVESTMENTS

The Corporation holds investments in Guaranteed Investment Certificates and Mutual Fund investments at current rates of interest maturing during the next year. The investments are carried at cost which approximates market.

1. GÉNÉRAL
