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Report of the Chair

I am very pleased to present this year's Chair's Report. 2016 has been both an exciting and challenging year for me in many respects. It has been exciting in regards to the new initiatives that CLRC has implemented in hiring new staff, and in the new, improved website that will be unveiled at the AGM in Ottawa that will incorporate many of the changes and upgrades that our member associations have requested. It has been challenging in that it is difficult to balance these improvements in structure and function and try to maintain a balanced budget with positive cash flow at the same time. However, I think that our staff and the board of directors have been able to do a great job of monitoring the budget this past year.

The staff have worked very hard over the past year to streamline processes and reduce the turnaround times as we know that has been a concern of many members over the past number of years. With the implementation of SNP Genomic testing at Delta Genomics, a new Laboratory in Edmonton, the reduction in turnaround time has been slower than anticipated. Over the year, the staff have worked closely with Delta to eliminate extra steps in processing lab work, and we have been able to see improvements in those turnaround times. We hope to see a further reduction in the coming year as more breeders get used to using the new online registration and transfer process which we anticipate will free up more of our registrars' time and allow the processing of more breeders work requests which will also have a positive effect on our budget.

I would like to thank all the staff at CLRC for the job that they do. I think it is commendable to see the years of service at CLRC that our senior staff have. In today's work environment, it is rare to see those years at one workplace and is one reason that so many of our members in different associations feel that they personally know their registrar, even though it is by voice. I feel it is important to recognize the work that all our staff do on a daily basis to do make CLRC successful. Thank you all. I would also like to welcome the new members of the CLRC staff and hope that you will enjoy your time at CLRC and the important work you do here.

I also want to thank the Board of Directors for the work and time they have dedicated to CLRC over the past year. They donate their time to provide direction and vision to CLRC, and represent all associations that CLRC provides services to. The Board has completed the Strategic Plan for CLRC which has been a large task but is very important in that it will provide the guidance and direction for future boards.

It has been my pleasure to have been elected as chair of CLRC for the past year and I look forward to the continued progression and success of this organization.

Rapport du Président

C'est avec un très grand plaisir que je présente le rapport annuel du président. L'année 2016 a été une année à la fois stimulante et remplie de défis pour moi à plusieurs égards. Elle a d'une part été stimulante en ce qui a trait aux nouvelles initiatives mises en œuvre par la SCEA, comme l'embauche de nouveaux membres du personnel et la refonte du site Web que l'on présentera à l'assemblée générale annuelle à Ottawa et qui intégrera bon nombre des modifications et améliorations que nos associations membres avaient demandées. D'autre part, l'année a été remplie de défis en ce sens qu'il est difficile d'apporter tous ces changements à la structure et au fonctionnement tout en essayant de maintenir un budget équilibré qui comporte un flux de trésorerie positif. Je pense néanmoins que notre personnel et le conseil d'administration ont réussi à faire un excellent travail de surveillance du budget durant l'année qui vient de s'écouler.

Le personnel a déployé beaucoup d'efforts au cours de l'année pour optimiser les processus et réduire les délais de traitement, puisque nous savons que cet aspect constitue une préoccupation de nombreux membres depuis quelques années. Avec la mise en place du test génomique des SNP chez Delta Genomics, un nouveau laboratoire à Edmonton, la réduction des délais de traitement a été plus lente que prévu. Pendant l'année, le personnel a collaboré étroitement avec Delta pour éliminer les étapes supplémentaires du travail de laboratoire et nous avons pu constater une amélioration dans ces délais de traitement. Nous espérons voir une réduction plus grande encore au cours de la prochaine année puisqu'un plus grand nombre d'élèves prennent l'habitude d'utiliser le nouveau processus d'enregistrement et de transfert en ligne. Nous nous attendons à ce que nos registraires aient ainsi un peu plus le temps de traiter un nombre accru de demandes présentées par les élèves, ce qui aura également un effet positif sur notre budget.

Je tiens par ailleurs à remercier tout le personnel de la SCEA pour leur travail. Je pense qu'il est remarquable de voir toutes les années de service qu'ont nos cadres supérieurs à la SCEA. Dans les milieux de travail actuels, il est rare de voir des personnes demeurer au même endroit toutes ces années. C'est une des raisons qui expliquent que tant de nos membres dans différentes associations ont le sentiment de connaître personnellement leur registraire, même si ce n'est que par téléphone. J'estime qu'il est important de reconnaître le travail accompli jour après jour par tous les membres de notre personnel pour assurer la réussite de la SCEA. Merci à tous! J'en profite également pour souhaiter la bienvenue aux nouveaux membres du personnel; j'espère que vous aurez du plaisir à la SCEA et dans l'important travail que vous y effectuez.

Je veux aussi remercier le conseil d'administration des efforts et du temps que ses membres ont consacrés à la SCEA tout au long de la dernière année. Les administrateurs donnent de leur temps pour fournir une orientation et une vision à la SCEA, et ils représentent toutes les associations à qui la SCEA offre des services. Le conseil d'administration a terminé l'élaboration du plan stratégique de la SCEA, ce qui n'était pas une mince tâche, et cette réalisation est très importante car le plan fournira les orientations et les indications qui aideront les futurs conseils d'administration.

J'ai été ravi d'être élu président de la SCEA pour l'année dernière et je me réjouis d'avance à l'idée que l'organisation continuera d'évoluer et de fonctionner avec succès.

General Manager's Report

In many ways the past year has been a turning point for CLRC. The Board of Directors and staff have finalized the Strategic Plan and have implemented many changes. With a commitment to providing **Leading Edge Technology, Quality Services, and Long Term Organizational Sustainability**, much attention has been made to investing in improvements internally as well as looking at business developments externally. As part of our Resource Audit, we completed the upgrade of all computers and software and engaged Rowland and Associates to develop a new Website and branding for CLRC. The website will include an updated Electronic Registry allowing users to access the system without having to download software first, allow for on-line payments, increased performance data display, the ability to review applications prior to submission, printing and tracking options, improved user interface as well as other enhanced features. We are very excited to present the new Website at this year's annual meeting.

Working closely with several Beef Breeds and Delta Genomics Lab, we completed the implementation for SNP Genomic testing. As a result, we saw an overall increase in testing by 69% over the previous year. Although positive, this also had the effect of slowing turnaround times in the cattle department. However, with improved processes and the addition of another Cattle Registrar in 2017, we expect to see the backlog and turnaround times reduced.

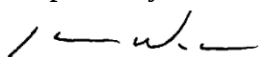
Other service improvements were introduced this year. Electronic bank statements are now fully integrated and paper copies eliminated, providing each association with small monthly savings as well as reducing mailing costs. Associations now have the option for individual accounts for phone and video conferencing, and we are researching new phone service options. In an effort to increase communications between CLRC and the associations, regular News Bulletins were provided throughout the year and will be continued. Membership Mailings saw a significant increase over last year, with CLRC sending out over 12,000 membership renewal notices or invitations to non-members for 35 associations.

Financially, we had projected a small surplus at year-end. However, due to investments in equipment and technology and a slight drop in volume of work (Units) processed, we closed 2016 with a deficit. The drop in Units was mainly a result of backlog in the Cattle department. All other departments saw increases ranging from 2% to 8%, and we expect to see this trend continue across the board in 2017.

As the backbone of the organization, I would like to recognize the staff who are so knowledgeable and work so diligently day to day on behalf of the breed associations and the individual breeders. They have embraced the challenge of accepting new technologies and processes, and although change is never easy, have each contributed to making CLRC a better Registry. Although all deserve recognition, I'm particularly pleased to congratulate Mavis MacDonald on her 35th anniversary as Registrar. Mavis not only celebrates 35 years of dedicated service, but has announced her retirement at the end of March 2017. On behalf of the staff, the Board and the many breeders that Mavis has worked with over the years, Thank You. We wish you a long and enjoyable retirement. Pamela Pearson will assume Mavis's position, and we are currently hiring two new Registrars, one to be trained in Equine and Swine, the other in Cattle. Both will start in April, and we expect this will improve turnaround times and customer service.

Finally, I would like to express my appreciation to the Board Directors for their continued support and leadership. They have made the commitment to represent the interests of all Associations and Breeders and are upholding the purpose of the Animal Pedigree Act of promoting breed improvement.

Rapport du Directeur Général

De bien des façons, la dernière année a marqué un tournant à la SCEA. Le conseil d'administration ainsi que le personnel ont finalisé le plan stratégique et ont mis en œuvre plusieurs changements. La SCEA s'étant engagée à **fournir un service à la pointe de la technologie, à assurer des prestations de qualité et à améliorer la pérennité de l'organisation à long terme**, une grande partie de l'attention a été mise sur les investissements dans les améliorations à l'interne et sur le développement des activités à l'externe. Dans le cadre de notre vérification des ressources, nous avons terminé la mise à niveau de tous les ordinateurs et logiciels et avons retenu les services de la société Rowland and Associates pour la conception de notre nouveau site Web et de la nouvelle image de marque de la SCEA. Le site Web comprendra un registre électronique mis à jour qui permettra aux utilisateurs d'accéder au système sans devoir télécharger le logiciel au préalable, de payer en ligne, d'avoir accès à plus de données sur la performance, de réviser une demande avant de la soumettre et d'accéder à des options d'impression et de suivi des demandes. Le site Web aura également une interface utilisateur améliorée ainsi que d'autres caractéristiques avancées. Nous sommes très enthousiastes à l'idée de présenter le nouveau site Web à l'assemblée générale annuelle de cette année.

En travaillant étroitement avec plusieurs éleveurs de races bovines ainsi que le laboratoire Delta Genomics, nous avons terminé la mise en place du test génomique des SNP. Comme résultat, nous avons constaté une augmentation globale du testage de l'ordre de 69 % par rapport à l'année dernière. Bien que cela soit positif, cela a aussi eu pour effet de ralentir les délais de traitement de la filière des races bovines. Par contre, avec l'amélioration des processus et l'ajout d'un autre registraire responsable des races bovines en 2017, nous nous attendons à une réduction du volume des demandes en attente et des délais de traitements.

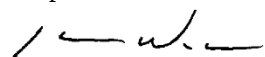
D'autres améliorations ont vu le jour cette année en matière de services. Les relevés bancaires électroniques sont maintenant totalement intégrés et les copies papier sont éliminées, ce qui a permis à chaque association de réaliser de petites économies mensuelles et de réduire les frais postaux. Les associations ont dorénavant la possibilité d'accéder à des comptes individuels pour les audioconférences et les visioconférences, et nous sommes à la recherche de nouvelles options pour le service téléphonique. Dans un effort d'amélioration des communications entre la SCEA et les associations, nous avons produit des bulletins réguliers tout au long de l'année et continuerons de le faire dans l'avenir. L'envoi de documentation concernant l'adhésion a fait un bond marqué au cours de l'année dernière, la SCEA ayant envoyé plus de 12 000 avis de renouvellement de cotisation ou d'invitations à des non-membres dans 35 associations.

Sur le plan financier, nous avons projeté un petit surplus en fin d'exercice. Cependant, en raison des investissements dans l'équipement et la technologie et d'une légère baisse du volume de travail (unités traitées), nous avons terminé l'exercice 2016 avec un déficit. La baisse du nombre d'unités traitées est principalement due aux retards dans la filière bovine. Dans toutes les autres filières, nous avons constaté des augmentations allant de 2 % à 8 %, et nous nous attendons à voir cette tendance se poursuivre dans toutes les associations du Conseil en 2017.

Étant au cœur de l'organisme, je suis à même de constater à quel point le personnel est informé et travaille de façon diligente, jour après jour, au nom des associations et des éleveurs individuels, et je les en remercie. Le personnel a relevé le défi et a accepté les nouvelles technologies et les nouveaux processus, et bien qu'il n'est jamais facile de changer, tous les membres du personnel ont contribué à faire de la SCEA un meilleur registre. Tout le monde mérite une reconnaissance, mais je tiens tout particulièrement à féliciter Mavis MacDonald pour son 35^e anniversaire à titre de registraire. Mavis non seulement a célébré 35 ans de loyaux services, mais elle a également annoncé sa retraite pour la fin du mois de mars 2017. Au nom du personnel, du conseil d'administration et des nombreux éleveurs avec qui Mavis a travaillé au fil de toutes ces années, merci! Nous lui souhaitons une longue et agréable retraite. Pamela Pearson occupera le poste de Mavis, et nous travaillons actuellement à l'embauche de deux autres registraires. L'une des deux personnes travaillera avec l'équipe chargée des races de chevaux et de porcs, l'autre s'occupera du bétail. Les deux nouveaux registraires commenceront en avril et nous nous attendons à ce que leur arrivée accélère les délais de traitement et améliore le service à la clientèle.

Pour terminer, je tiens à exprimer ma gratitude aux membres du conseil d'administration pour leur soutien et leur leadership continus. Ils ont pris l'engagement de représenter les intérêts de toutes les associations et de tous les éleveurs et soutiennent la *Loi sur la généalogie des animaux* dont le but est de promouvoir l'amélioration des races.

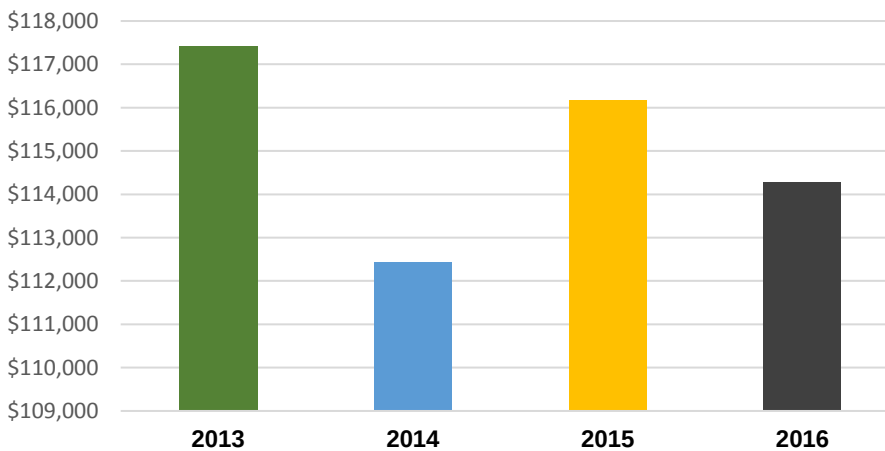
Total Pedigrees Registered 2013-2016



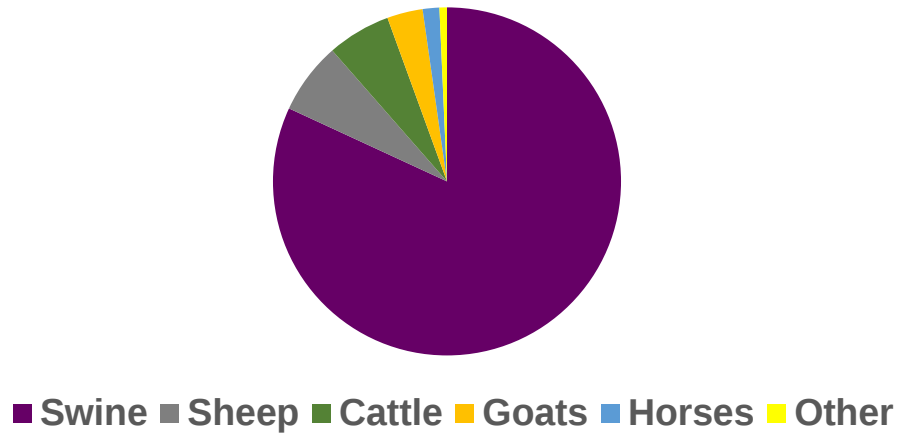
Total Transfers Registered 2013-2016



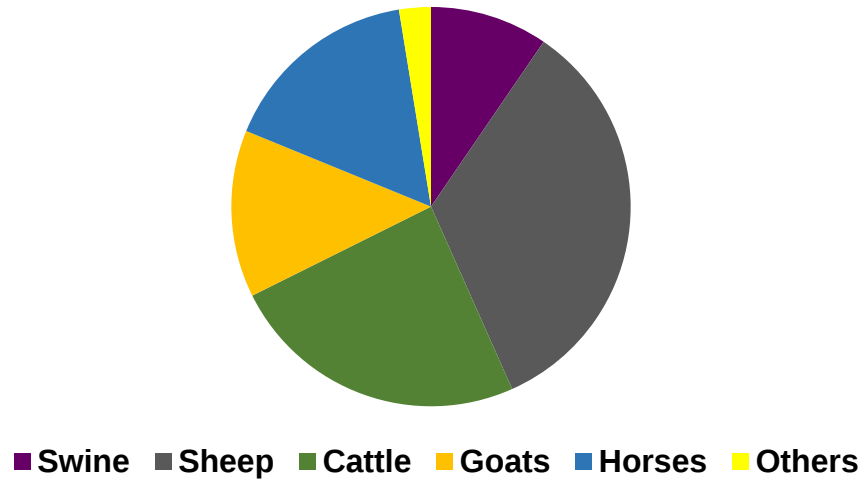
Total Units 2013-2016
