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Report of the Chair

2019 was a year that started out with a positive beginning and a successful AGM in Ottawa. The Board of Directors and the staff had what was felt to be a constructive meeting, where the strategic plan was discussed and we all got to know each other a little better. The year started with a balanced budget and the knowledge that the Board was going to have to look at an increase in unit costs for the upcoming budget year 2020. It was recognized that it had been some time since a comprehensive study of the registrar times involved in each unit transaction had been undertaken and that with the increased use of the electronic registry, it was time for a new unit cost analysis study and that this information would be used to revamp the unit costs going into 2020. However due to staff turnovers and some extended medical leaves, our staff were under much increased pressure to train new staff and increased workloads from additional breeds being redistributed amongst the registrars. This all resulted in lower units processed during 2019 than was budgeted for and subsequently CLRC sustained a significant financial loss. The board of directors approved the hiring of Ron Black on a contract basis in order to help with the processing of the backlog of registry work and also to assist with training of our new registrars. The unit cost analysis, which was started in late 2019 had to be delayed as it was discovered that this program to collect the data was slowing down the entire system which we could not have happened, especially given the volume of work that was coming in.

The board approved an increase in fees for 2020 as it was evident that a significant increase was necessary to create sufficient income to allow for replacement equipment, the ability to add new staff as needed and to continue to improve and add services for all of our member associations. We are continually getting membership requests from new associations and if CLRC is to grow and become self sustaining, we must be able to generate the revenue to allow this to happen. As I write this report, we have just come through the Covid 19 pandemic and have had to adjust to a new way of doing business with staff working remotely and on alternating work schedules. Covid has caused all of us to re-evaluate how we conduct our business and CLRC is no different. This new work environment will involve new hardware and computer programs and CLRC needs to be able to take advantage when the opportunities arise. Our staff have done an admirable job in adapting to the new realities and have kept up with the amount of work coming in from our members. We currently have a positive cash flow for 2020 and this is allowing staff and the board to look positively to the future and concentrate on the improvements and changes that have been outlined in our 5 year strategic plan.

I want to thank all of our staff and the Board of Directors for their work and commitment to the success of CLRC. I want to welcome our new registrars, Caleigh Jerry, Melanie Overduin, and Julie Siebel to the staff of CLRC. Also, Glenn Clark announced his retirement from CLRC effective April of 2020. We all congratulate Glenn and his 43 years at CLRC and wish him all the best in his retirement. Thank you also to all of our member associations for their patience and understanding during 2019 as we all are looking forward to a better and more positive year in 2020.

Rapport du Président

L'année 2019 a débuté sur une note positive avec une assemblée générale annuelle réussie à Ottawa. Le conseil d'administration et le personnel ont eu une assemblée constructive, durant laquelle le plan stratégique a été examiné de près et tout le monde a pu apprendre à se connaître un peu plus. Nous avons commencé l'année avec un budget équilibré et savions que le conseil d'administration aurait à étudier la possibilité d'augmenter les coûts unitaires pour l'année budgétaire de 2020. Nous avons reconnu qu'il s'était passé un certain temps depuis que nous avions examiné en détail le temps que passent nos registraires à chaque transaction et que, avec l'utilisation accrue du registre électronique, il était temps de procéder à une nouvelle analyse des coûts unitaires pour ensuite utiliser cette information afin d'ajuster les montants en vigueur pour 2020. Toutefois, en raison du roulement de personnel et de congés de maladie prolongés, notre personnel a été soumis à une pression beaucoup plus forte afin de réussir à former les nouveaux membres du personnel tout en assumant une charge de travail accrue en raison de la redistribution des associations d'éleveurs entre les registraires. Au bout du compte, un nombre inférieur d'unités ont été traitées en 2019 par rapport à ce qui avait été prévu au budget et la SCEA a subi une perte financière importante. Le conseil d'administration a approuvé l'embauche de Ron Black sur une base contractuelle afin d'aider au traitement des dossiers en retard et à la formation des nouveaux registraires. L'analyse des coûts unitaires, qui avait été entamée à la fin de 2019, a dû être reportée, car on a découvert que le programme utilisé pour collecter les données ralentissait tout le système, ce que l'on ne pouvait se permettre en particulier en raison du volume de travail à venir.

Le conseil d'administration a approuvé une augmentation des frais d'unités pour 2020 puisqu'il était clair qu'une hausse significative était nécessaire pour générer des recettes suffisantes nous permettant de remplacer du matériel, d'embaucher du personnel au besoin et de continuer à améliorer et à ajouter des services pour nos associations membres. Nous recevons continuellement des demandes d'inscription de la part de nouvelles associations et si nous voulons que la SCEA se développe et devienne autosuffisante, nous devons être en mesure de générer les recettes requises pour répondre à ces demandes. Au moment où j'écris le présent rapport, nous traversons la pandémie de COVID-19 et avons dû nous ajuster à une nouvelle façon de travailler, notre personnel travaillant à distance et selon des horaires variables. La pandémie de COVID-19 a obligé tout le monde à réévaluer sa façon de mener ses activités et la SCEA ne fait pas exception. Ce nouvel environnement de travail exigera du matériel et des programmes informatiques différents et la SCEA doit être en mesure de tirer parti des possibilités qui se présenteront. Notre personnel a fait un travail admirable en s'adaptant aux nouvelles réalités tout en continuant de répondre aux demandes de nos membres. Nous avons actuellement un flux de trésorerie positif pour 2020 et cela permet au personnel et au conseil d'administration de regarder positivement vers l'avenir et de se concentrer sur les améliorations et les changements à apporter conformément à notre plan stratégique quinquennal.

Je tiens à remercier tous les membres de notre personnel et du conseil d'administration pour leur travail et leur engagement à contribuer à la réussite de la SCEA. Je veux aussi souhaiter la bienvenue à nos nouveaux registraires Caleigh Jerry, Melanie Overduin et Julie Siebel au sein du personnel de la SCEA. Également, Glenn Clark a annoncé son départ à la retraite pour le mois d'avril 2020. Nous félicitons tous Glenn et le remercions de ses 43 ans passés à la SCEA, et nous lui souhaitons une formidable retraite. Merci également à toutes nos associations membres de leur patience et de leur compréhension durant l'année 2019. Nous souhaitons tous que l'année 2020 soit meilleure et plus positive.

General Manager's Report

To the members and association representatives, I am pleased to report on behalf of the Canadian Livestock Records Corporation (CLRC).

I am currently writing this report from my home office during the COVID 19 Pandemic, which has caused disruptions to normal operations at CLRC as it has for millions across Canada and throughout the world. As challenging as it has been for everyone, CLRC has maintained the office open, continuing to serve breeders and breed associations. I would like to recognize the staff that accepted the challenging working conditions, and who proved to be flexible and determined to work on a rotational basis to keep operations moving fluidly, as well as looking after their personal family concerns. We have learned many lessons during this period and will continue to adapt as we move forward. More on this next year.

Last year's annual meeting, held in Ottawa, hosted a dynamic group of Association members. CLRC presented developments and new features of the Website and updates to the Electronic Registry. During the interactive session, members in attendance gave us a resounding message that they want to see continued investments in electronic services, improved customer experience, and reduced turnaround times. As such, the predominant focus for 2019 was a significant development in our systems and as it turned out, our staffing.

We improved many features of the Website as requested, including enhanced on-line registration, search functions, increased data display, and many other features that we will continue to develop.

On the staffing front, we had several challenges. Two staff required medical leave, and there was an additional change of three Registrars. We approached this as our re-building phase, and completed the hiring of Caleigh Jerry as Cattle Registrar, funded in part through a grant sponsored by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada, Julie Seibel as Equine Registrar, and Melanie Overduin as Sheep Registrar. Mohamed Ismail, Admin Clerk for the past four years, stepped in and filled the position of Goat Registrar as we trained the new staff and re-distributed breeds to other Registrars. Mohamed continues to work closely with Melanie as they manage the Goat and Sheep registries together.

At the end of the year, Glenn Clark announced his retirement for April 2020. After 43 years of service, Glenn will be missed by all but leaves behind a special legacy. Charlotte Jantz-Lee was hired as the new Systems Manager, and is scheduled to start in January, with an overlap until April with Glenn.

In spite of a projected financial surplus for the year, we closed the year with a realized year-end deficit of \$78,430. This was due primarily to the staffing changes, and subsequent training required which came from other staff further reducing our resources. This resulted in processing lower volumes of units (-7.1%) than anticipated and negatively affecting turnaround. However, all the new Registrars have proven to be most effective and efficient, and as of the date of writing this report, we are producing approximately 15% over what we had achieved for the same period last year, and our turnaround times are improving.


On a positive note, membership mailings were completed in the fall for thirty one associations, with mailings going out to over 11,000 members and non-members owning animals. New this year, we offered a successful and well received electronic mailing, setting the associations up for significant savings in subsequent years, as costs were reduced from \$2.00 per mailing to .75 cents. With breeders updating their e-mail addresses, associations will be able to send more regular and affordable communications.

We continue to get interest from a wide variety of breed associations to manage their registry, and this will become a focus of development for next year. We are currently finalizing the programming to accommodate the American Blonde d'Aquitaine Association.

I would like to recognize the staff who continue to work diligently on behalf of the breed associations and individual breeders, and I would like to thank the breeders for their patience while new staff were being trained in their roles as Registrars. I believe we have a very strong team heading into 2020, and I look forward to a positive report for the coming year.

Finally, I would like to thank the Board of Directors. This has been a challenging year, and the Board has continued to provide support and leadership in representing all Associations with CLRC. Due to increasing operating costs and programming developments, the Board approved an increase in the Unit cost for 2020, which should provide the necessary funds to achieve our strategic goals. Working closely together with staff, we anticipate significant improvements for 2020.

Rapport du Directeur Général

Aux membres et représentants des associations, j'ai le plaisir de vous adresser au nom de la Société canadienne d'enregistrement des animaux (S.C.E.A.) ; j'écris ce rapport de mon bureau à domicile pendant la pandémie de COVID 19, qui a perturbé les activités normales de la S.C.E.A., comme cela a été le cas pour des millions de Canadiens et de partout à travers le monde. Aussi difficile que cela ait été, la S.C.E.A. a maintenu portes ouvertes, continuant de servir les éleveurs et les associations. Je tiens à remercier le personnel qui a excellé face à ces conditions de travail difficiles et qui s'est démontré flexible et déterminé à travailler par rotation pour maintenir la fluidité des opérations, ainsi que pour répondre à leurs préoccupations familiales personnelles. Nous avons tiré de nombreuses leçons au cours de cette période et nous continuerons de nous adapter. Plus continuerons de vous mettre à jour au fil de l'année.

L'assemblée annuelle de l'année dernière, tenue à Ottawa, a accueilli un groupe dynamique de membres de l'Association. La S.C.E.A. a présenté les nouveautés et les mises à jour fonctionnelles du site Web et du registre électronique.

Au cours de la session interactive, les membres présents nous ont fait savoir qu'ils souhaitent voir des investissements continus au niveau des services électroniques, une meilleure expérience en ce qui concerne le service à la clientèle, ainsi qu'une réduction de délais d'exécution. En tant que tel, les objectifs prédominants pour 2019 étaient; l'amélioration de nos systèmes et le développement de notre personnel. Tel que demandé, nous avons amélioré de nombreuses fonctionnalités au niveau du site Web, y compris l'enregistrement en ligne simplifié, des fonctions de recherche, un affichage accru des données et de nombreuses autres fonctionnalités que nous continuerons à développer.

Du côté de la formation personnel, nous surmonté certains défis; deux membres du personnel ont eu besoin d'un congé de maladie et il y a eu un changement de trois registraires. Nous avons relevé ce défi et nous avons embauché Caleigh Jerry en tant que registraire des bovins, (financé en partie par une subvention parrainée par Agriculture et Agroalimentaire Canada), Julie Seibel en tant que registraire équine et Melanie Overduin en tant que registraire des moutons. Mohamed Ismail, assistant administratif depuis quatre ans, a accepté le poste de registraire de chèvre pendant que nous formions le nouveau personnel et considérions la redistribution de la charge de travail des registraires.

À la fin de l'année, Glenn Clark a annoncé sa retraite pour avril 2020. Après 43 ans de service, Glenn manquera à tous, mais laisse un héritage spécial. Charlotte Jantz-Lee a été embauchée en tant que nouvelle directrice des systèmes et devrait commencer en janvier, avec un chevauchement jusqu'en avril avec Glenn.

Malgré un excédent financier prévu pour l'année, nous avons clôturé l'année avec un déficit de fin d'année réalisé de 78 430 \$. Cela est principalement dû aux changements de personnel et à la formation supplémentaire requise qui est venue d'autres membres du personnel, réduisant encore nos ressources. Cela s'est traduit par le traitement d'un volume d'unités plus faible (-7,1 %) que prévu et un impact négatif sur le délai d'exécution. Cependant, tous les nouveaux bureaux d'enregistrement se sont révélé les plus efficaces et les plus efficientes, et à la date de rédaction de ce rapport, nous produisons environ 15 % de plus que ce que nous avions réalisé pour la même période l'année dernière, et nos délais d'exécution s'améliorent.

Plus positivement, les envois d'adhésion ont été complétés à l'automne pour trente et une associations, avec des envois de plus de 11 000 membres et non-membres possédant des animaux. Nouveauté pour cette

année ; nous avons offert un envoi électronique réussi et bien reçu, ce qui a permis aux associations de réaliser d'importantes économies au cours des années subséquentes. Les coûts ont été réduits de 2,00 \$ par envoi à 0,75 centime. Plus les éleveurs mettant à jour leur adresse e-mail, plus les associations pourront envoyer des communications régulières et abordables.

Nous continuons de susciter l'intérêt d'une grande variété d'associations de races pour gérer leur registre, et cela deviendra un axe de développement pour l'année prochaine. Nous finalisons actuellement la programmation pour accueillir l'American Blonde d'Aquitaine Association.

Je tiens à remercier le personnel qui continue de travailler avec diligence au nom des associations d'éleveurs et des éleveurs individuels, et je tiens à remercier les éleveurs pour leur patience pendant que le nouveau personnel soit confortable dans leur formation et dans leurs rôles de registraires. Je crois que nous avons une équipe très solide pour 2020, et j'attends avec impatience un rapport positif pour l'année à venir.

Enfin, je voudrais remercier le conseil d'administration. Cette année a été difficile et le conseil d'administration a continué de fournir un soutien et un leadership pour représenter toutes les associations auprès du S.C.E.A. En raison d'augmentation des coûts d'exploitation d'entreprise et de soutien systématique, le Conseil a approuvé une augmentation du coût unitaire pour 2020, ce qui devrait fournir les fonds nécessaires pour atteindre nos objectifs stratégiques. Ensemble avec le personnel, nous prévoyons des améliorations significatives pour 2020.

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Independent Auditor's Report

**To the members of
Canadian Livestock Records Corporation**

Opinion

We have audited the financial statements of Canadian Livestock Records Corporation (the Corporation), which comprise the statement of financial position as at December 31, 2019, and the statements of operations, changes in net assets and cash flows for the year then ended, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies.

In our opinion, the accompanying financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the Corporation as at December 31, 2019, and its financial performance and its cash flows for the year then ended in accordance with Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit organizations.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the *Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements* section of our report. We are independent of the Corporation in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial statements in Canada, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Responsibilities of Management and Those Charged with Governance for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit organizations, and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial statements, management is responsible for assessing the Corporation's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless management either intends to liquidate the Corporation or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

Those charged with governance are responsible for overseeing the Corporation's financial reporting process.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these financial statements.

Status and Purpose of Organization	The Canadian Livestock Records Corporation (the "Corporation") is a private non-profit organization that was established under section 35 of the Animal Pedigree Act. The Corporation is the national pedigree service for purebred and non-purebred livestock in Canada. The Corporation is a non-profit organization under the Income Tax Act and, as such, is exempt from income taxes.

The payment is due to all terminated full-time employees employed for ten years or more as long as termination is not for cause. The current provision is intended to fully provide for this potential liability should all employees be eligible for the maximum pay-out.		
Deferred Revenue	Upon withdrawal, member associations are assessed a charge related to their share of committed future costs. This charge is deferred and then amortized to income as the costs are incurred.		
Reserve Fund	The reserve fund represents an accumulation of operating surpluses and deficits less interfund transfers over the life of the Corporation. The purpose of the reserve fund is to assist in the funding of future capital outlays and to cover operating deficits. Upon withdrawal, member associations are entitled to their share of the reserve fund and are responsible for their share of a reserve fund deficit.		
Contingency Reserve Fund	The fund is used to provide for potential future costs of severance obligations to staff if and after it becomes necessary to terminate their employment as a result of downsizing resulting from the withdrawal of member associations. The amount allocated to this fund annually is determined by the Board of Directors.		
Permanent Capital Fund	This fund represents the balance contributed to the Corporation in the form of a forgiven loan from the Department of Agriculture. The amount allocated to this fund was determined by the Board of Directors.

Internally Restricted Fund	This fund ensures operating capital in the situation that employees entitled to severance payouts for accumulated sick leave, vacation or overtime, leave and there are insufficient funds in the operating budget to fully pay the amounts owing them. The funds may be used to cover severance for employees retiring or quitting, or for necessary organizational downsizing. No amount was allocated for the year ended December 31, 2019 (2018 - \$nil).
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2. Cash

The cash balance includes amounts belonging to unrelated groups for whom the Corporation deals with in a foreign currency. Funds of \$29,721 USD (2018 - \$22,214 USD) and \$1,028 CDN (2018 - \$1,028 CDN) are held within the Corporation's bank accounts. The corresponding trust obligation is recorded in accounts payable and accrued liabilities.

11. Internal Transfers

Amounts of \$50,438, \$44,952 and \$29,577 were transferred respectively from the contingency reserve fund, the permanent capital fund and the internally restricted fund to the reserve fund in order to fund the deficiency. The Corporation may not use these internally restricted amounts for any other purpose without the approval of the board of directors.

12. Financial Instruments

Liquidity risk

The Corporation is exposed to the liquidity risk mainly in respect of accounts payable and accrued liabilities, accrued vacation pay and sick leave provision.

Credit risk

The Corporation is exposed to credit risk for its other receivables and due from Breed Associations. The Corporation provides credit to its members in the normal course of its operations and assesses, on a continuous basis, these receivables on the basis of amounts it is virtually certain to receive.

Currency risk

Approximately 14% of the Corporation's activities are in foreign currency. Consequently, some assets are exposed to foreign exchange fluctuations. At December 31, 2019, cash of \$30,733 (2018 - \$21,371) are denominated in US dollars and converted into Canadian dollars.

There have not been any changes in the risks from the prior year.




Total Pedigrees Registered 2016-2019




