As part of the long term strategic plan for CLRC, we will be looking to add another programmer to the staff which has been needed for many years and will allow CLRC to respond to programming requests from our member associations much quicker than in the past.

The incoming board of directors will be looking at a new 5 year strategic plan which will have to deal with some new challenges such as bringing in new associations, computer program replacements and of course always considering staffing and improving our service to our member associations. The challenges never seem to decline, just change in priority.

I want to thank all the board members and all the staff at CLRC for their contributions over the last year. Sadly, I also report that we lost one of our long term directors last year as Myrna Flesch passed in June. Myrna's opinion was very valued and she will be missed. Thank you to all the staff for continuing to process all incoming work as efficiently as possible in these trying times. We have gained valuable insight that will help CLRC in the coming years.

Thank your to all that joined our virtual AGM, please stay safe and I hope to be able to meet you at an in-person AGM in the not too distant future.

RAPPORT DU PRÉSIDENT

C'est avec plaisir que je présente ce rapport aux membres de la SCEA pour l'année 2020. Jamais au cours de l'histoire de la SCEA nous n'avons eu une année comme 2020, remplie d'incertitudes, de craintes par rapport à la pandémie et de préoccupations face aux changements qui nous sont imposés, sans trop savoir ce que l'avenir nous réserve. Encore aujourd'hui, nous sommes confrontés aux effets de la pandémie de COVID-19 et je sais qu'après une année de fermetures et de confinements, nous sommes tous fatigués de la situation. Les enjeux ne diminuent pas, mais ce sont les priorités qui changent.

Je tiens à remercier tous les membres du conseil d'administration et du personnel de la SCEA de leur contribution tout au long de l'année dernière. Tristement, nous avons également perdu une de nos anciens membres du conseil d'administration avec le décès de Myrna Flesch, en juin dernier. Nous avons toujours beaucoup apprécié le point de vue de Myrna et elle nous manquera. J'aimerais aussi remercier tout le personnel de leurs efforts continus en vue de traiter toutes les demandes aussi efficacement que possible en cette période difficile. Nous avons acquis une expérience précieuse qui aidera la SCEA dans les prochaines années.

General Manager's Report

To all breeders and association representatives, I am pleased to report to you on behalf of the Canadian Livestock Records Corporation (CLRC).

As I write this year's report, I reflect that it has been a full year since staff were sent home until further notice due to an unknown viral pandemic. The Annual Meeting scheduled for April 14th in Calgary, was postponed and finally held October 3rd by ZOOM videoconference. This was the first time in CLRC's 115 year history that the Annual Meeting was not held face-to-face. The response was positive, but not the same. Sadly, we also lost a dear friend and dedicated Board Member with the passing of Myrna Flesch.

As you are all fully aware, COVID continues to affect us all, and cause disruptions to normal business operations. Deemed an essential service, CLRC was able to remain open, and the staff continued to serve breeders and breed associations without loss of work. Staff are currently being outfitted with new laptops in order to be more effective and efficient working remotely.

In spite of Canada Post delays and reduced access and the closure of some suppliers, we managed to complete membership mailings and regular output with minimal delays. The electronic mailing proved to be a big success, significantly reducing the cost for associations to reach members. The CLRC year-end results for 2020 are positive. The Units (work production) finished the year at 15.8% over the previous year, and we realized a small financial year-end surplus.

The budget for 2021 is being presented by the Board based on projected increased expenses and investments in CLRC staffing and resources, and a slight increase of .15 cents in Unit costs, and an increase in unit production. The Board and management feel this is necessary in order to meet demands, stay competitive and afford the necessary resources to offer quality services to breeders and breed associations.

In the coming year, the Board has committed to the development and implementation of a new five year Strategic Plan. Some areas of interest to be included are; Website review and development, electronic registry services, improved on-line payment options, review of current database and exploration of alternatives, marketing and communications, fund development, and staff development and succession planning.

I would like to recognize the staff who continue to work on behalf of the breed associations and individual breeders, and I would like to thank the breeders for their patience during these trying times. Following the retirement of Glenn Clark in April 2020, CLRC hired a new Programmer, Gabriel Kronfeld. We also employed the on-line services of an APPX database consultant Bob Spitz to assist with immediate programming demands and training. We are currently hiring a new Registrar and an additional programming staff to accommodate our growth objectives.

Finally, I would like to thank the Board of Directors for their continued support and leadership in representing all Associations with CLRC. I believe we have a very strong team heading into 2021, and I look forward to a positive report for the coming year.

Rapport du directeur général

À tous les éleveurs et les représentants d'association, c'est avec grand plaisir que je vous soumets le présent rapport au nom de la Société canadienne d'enregistrement des animaux (SCEA).

En rédigeant ce rapport annuel, je réfléchissais au fait que cela faisait déjà un an que le personnel était tenu de travailler de la maison en raison d'une pandémie due à un virus inconnu. L'assemblée générale annuelle, initialement prévue le 14 avril à Calgary, a été reportée pour finalement avoir lieu le 3 octobre par vidéoconférence ZOOM. C'était la première fois en 115 ans d'histoire que l'assemblée annuelle de la SCEA ne se déroulait pas en personne. La réponse a été positive, sans être tout à fait pareille. Tristement, nous avons aussi perdu une amie chère et une membre du conseil d'administration dévouée avec le décès de Myrna Flesch.

Comme vous le savez très bien, la COVID-19 continue de nous affecter tous et de perturber les activités commerciales normales. Considérée comme un service essentiel, la SCEA a pu demeurer ouverte et son personnel a continué de servir les éleveurs et les associations sans perte de travail. Nous nous employons actuellement à fournir à notre personnel de nouveaux ordinateurs portables pour leur permettre de travailler à distance avec plus d'efficacité.

Malgré les retards de Postes Canada et un accès réduit ou une fermeture de certains fournisseurs, nous avons réussi à procéder à l'envoi postal aux membres et aux envois réguliers en minimisant les retards. L'envoi par voie électronique s'est révélé un véritable succès, réduisant grandement les frais pour les associations dans les communications à leurs membres. Les résultats de fin d'année de la SCEA pour 2020 sont positifs. Le traitement du nombre d'unités (production de travail) est de 15,8 % supérieur à celui de l'année précédente, et nous avons terminé l'année avec un léger surplus financier.


Le budget de 2021 est présenté par le conseil d'administration et se fonde sur une hausse projetée des dépenses et des investissements relativement au personnel et aux ressources de la SCEA, ainsi qu'une légère augmentation des coûts unitaires de 15 cents et une augmentation des unités de production. Le conseil d'administration et la direction ont le sentiment que ces augmentations sont nécessaires pour que nous puissions répondre aux demandes, demeurer concurrentiels et acquérir les ressources nous permettant d'offrir des services de qualité aux éleveurs et aux associations.

Au cours de l'année qui vient, le conseil d'administration a comme objectif d'élaborer et de mettre en œuvre un nouveau plan stratégique quinquennal. On y inclura certains domaines d'intérêt tels que : révision et développement du site Web, services d'enregistrement électronique, amélioration des options de paiement en ligne, révision de la base de données actuelle et exploration des solutions de rechange, marketing et communications, financement, perfectionnement du personnel et planification de la relève.

Je tiens à reconnaître le travail du personnel qui continue d'agir au nom des associations de race et des éleveurs individuels, et j'aimerais remercier les éleveurs de leur patience durant cette période difficile. Après le départ à la retraite de Glenn Clark en avril 2020, la SCEA a embauché un nouveau programmeur, Gabriel Kronfeld. Nous avons aussi fait appel aux services en ligne d'un consultant en bases de données APPX, Bob Spitz, pour nous aider avec les demandes immédiates liées à la programmation et la formation. Nous travaillons actuellement à l'embauche de nouvelles personnes pour un poste de registraire et de membre du personnel de programmation en vue de mener à bien nos objectifs de croissance.

Pour terminer, je tiens à remercier le conseil d'administration de son soutien continu et de son leadership dans la représentation des différentes associations auprès de la SCEA. Nous entamons l'année 2021 avec une équipe très forte, avec laquelle je pense que nous aurons des résultats positifs cette année.

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

Opinion

In preparing the financial statements, Management is responsible for assessing the Corporation's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless Management either intends to liquidate the Corporation or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

Those charged with governance are responsible for overseeing the Corporation's financial reporting process.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these financial statements.

However, future events or conditions may cause the Corporation to cease to continue as a going concern.
- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the financial statements, including the disclosures, and whether the financial statements represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.

We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.

1. STATUS AND PURPOSE OF ORGANIZATION

The Canadian Livestock Records Corporation (the "Corporation") is a non-profit organization that was established under section 35 of the Animal Pedigree Act. The Corporation is the national pedigree service for purebred and non-purebred livestock in Canada. The Corporation is a non-profit organization under the Income Tax Act and, as such, is exempt from income taxes.

2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit organizations and include the following significant accounting policies:

Term Deposits

The Corporation initially measures its term deposits at fair value. The Corporation subsequently measures its term deposits at amortized cost, and tests for impairment when there are indicators of possible impairment.

Capital Assets

Capital assets are recorded at cost and amortized on the basis of their useful life using the following methods and durations:

Computer software and equipment	- 5 years straight-line basis
Office equipment	- 5 years straight-line basis

Intangible Asset and Leased Intangible Asset

Intangible assets are recorded at cost and amortized on the basis of their useful life using the following methods and durations:

Website	- 5 years straight-line basis
Server under capital lease	- 5 years straight-line basis

The Corporation capitalizes development costs when Management believes they will generate future benefits and that all the criteria for capitalization are met.

2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (continued)

Impairment of Long-Lived Assets

When a tangible capital asset or intangible asset no longer has any long-term service potential to the Corporation, the excess of its net carrying amount over any residual value is recognized as an expense in the Statement of Operations.

Sick Leave

The Corporation has a sick leave policy which currently allows the payment of two days of accumulated sick leave per complete year of service to a maximum of 60 days. The payment is due to all terminated full-time employees employed for ten years or more as long as termination is not for cause. The current provision is intended to fully provide for this potential liability should all employees be eligible for the maximum pay-out.

Reserve Fund

The reserve fund represents an accumulation of operating surpluses and deficits less interfund transfers over the life of the Corporation. The purpose of the reserve fund is to assist in the funding of future capital outlays and to cover operating deficits. Upon withdrawal, member associations are entitled to their share of the reserve fund and are responsible for their share of a reserve fund deficit.

Internally Restricted Fund

The internally restricted fund ensures operating capital in the situation that employees entitled to severance payouts for accumulated sick leave, vacation or overtime, leave and there are insufficient funds in the operating budget to fully pay the amounts owing to them. The funds may be used to cover severance for employees retiring or quitting, or from necessary organizational downsizing. No amount was allocated for the year ended December 31, 2020 (2019 - \$nil).

Foreign Currency Translation

Monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are translated into Canadian dollars at exchange rates in effect at year end. Revenues and expenses are translated at the rate of exchange prevailing at the time of the transactions. Exchange gains and losses resulting from the translation of these amounts are recorded in the Statement of Operations.

2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (continued)

Revenue Recognition

The Corporation follows the deferral method of accounting for contributions. Restricted contributions are recognized as revenue in the year in which the related expenses are incurred. Unrestricted contributions are recognized as revenue in the year received or receivable, if the amount to be received can be reasonably estimated and collection is reasonably assured.

All other revenues are recognized when services are rendered.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit organizations requires Management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amount of assets and liabilities, and contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenue and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from these estimates.

3. CASH

The cash balance includes amounts belonging to unrelated groups for whom the Corporation deals with in a foreign currency. Funds of \$25,010 USD (2019 - \$29,721 USD) and \$973 CAD (2019 - \$1,028 CAD) are held within the Corporation's bank accounts. The corresponding trust obligation is recorded in accounts payable and accrued liabilities.

4. TERM DEPOSITS AND ACCRUED INTEREST

Term deposits include a redeemable, guaranteed investment certificate earning interest at 0.55% (2019 - 1.60%) and maturing in July 2021.

8. CEBA LOAN

The Canada Emergency Business Account (CEBA) is an interest-free loan and \$20,000 of the loan is forgivable if the Corporation repays the loan on or before December 31, 2022. If the loan is not repaid by that date, the loan can be converted to a three-year term loan at an interest rate of 5%.

9. CONTRACTUAL OBLIGATIONS

The Corporation leases its premises, including common charges for utilities and waste removal, under a lease expiring in December 2024. Future minimum lease payments are required as follows:

10. FINANCIAL INSTRUMENTS

The Corporation's financial instruments consist of cash, term deposits and accrued interest, other receivables, due from Breed Associations, accounts payable and accrued liabilities, accrued vacation pay, sick leave provision and CEBA loan. It is Management's opinion that the fair value of these instruments is not materially different than their cost and that the Corporation is not exposed to significant credit, interest rate, foreign currency or liquidity risk.

Credit Risk

The Corporation is exposed to credit risk in the event of non-performance by counterparties in connection with its other receivables. The Corporation provides credit to its members in the normal course of its operations and assesses, on a continuous basis, these receivables on the basis of amounts it is virtually certain to receive.

Interest Rate Risk

The Corporation is exposed to interest rate risk with respect to its interest-bearing term deposits and obligations under capital lease.

Foreign Currency Risk

At December 31, 2020, cash of \$1,076 (2019 - \$1,315) are denominated in US dollars and converted into Canadian dollars.

Liquidity Risk

The Corporation is exposed to the liquidity risk mainly in respect of its accounts payable and accrued liabilities, accrued vacation pay, and sick leave provision.

There have not been any changes in the risks from the prior year.
