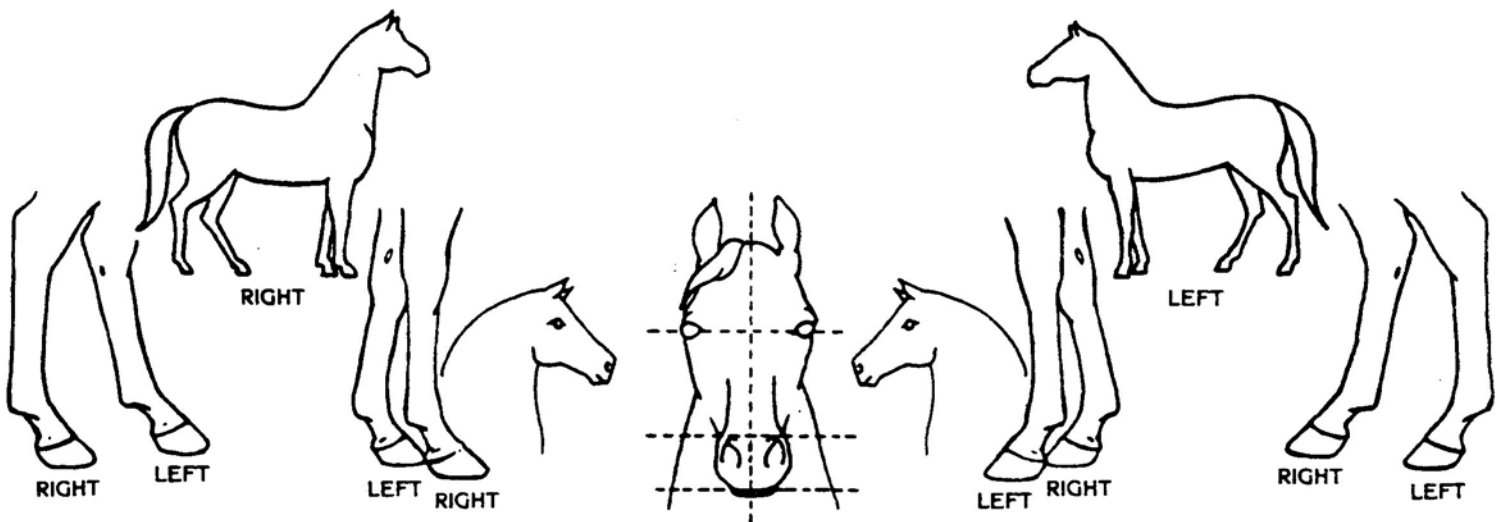
INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION OF DECLARATION TO ACQUIRE A DUPLICATE CERTIFICATE

1. FORM MUST BE COMPLETED IN THE PRESENCE OF A PERSON AUTHORIZED TO ADMINISTER OATHS
2. FILL IN NAME, ADDRESS AND IDENTIFICATION NUMBER OF APPLICANT.
3. FILL IN NAME, REGISTRATION NUMBER AND BREED OF ANIMAL IF POSSIBLE.
4. TATTOO OF ANIMAL OR COMPLETE COLOUR DESCRIPTION AND DIAGRAM IN THE CASE OF HORSES.
5. STATE WHY THE ORIGINAL CERTIFICATE IS NOT AVAILABLE.
6. SEND DECLARATION TO CANADIAN LIVESTOCK RECORDS CORPORATION, 2417 HOLLY LANE , OTTAWA, ON K1V 0M7 WITH \$_____.

3. Include any scars or brands the horse may have that may be helpful in identifying the horse.
4. Clear photographs of the markings may help to speed processing, especially for horses that have unusual markings or high leg markings.
5. Mark the location of the forehead cowlick(s) (hair whorl) with an X. Indicate accurately if to the right/left or above/below the guidelines.
