<b>Instructions for Collecting a Good Hair Sample:</b> Collect hair from the mane above the wither . 35-45 hairs are required. Wrap several strands around fingers and pull up. <b>The translucent hair follicles on the end of the hair shaft are required.</b> Do not touch the follicles. You may need to pull several times. Put hair follicles together and secure with tape to a clean sheet of paper. Insert into an envelope labelled with the horse's identity and seal envelope. Do not place into plastic Ziploc bags. <b>Submit with Registration Application.</b>
